Aims:

- To state the main aims of the Health & Safety at Work Acts 1974 and associated regulations

- To understand the need for safe erection and dismantling procedures
- To train the user to a level of competence to carry out inspections on mobile access towers
- To create safe systems of work while working with mobile access towers
- To understand employees responsibilities
